Modern pop provocateur Kesha wore this zippered bodysuit on stage.

Pop superstar Katy Perry wore this suede belt in the video for her breakthrough hit, "I Kissed a Girl".

BOB DYLAN BLACK BOOTS

These boots belonged to the one and only Bob Dylan. While wearing them on stage one night, Bob walked over to his guitar tech and asked him to find another pair because these were "jinxed".

SLASH CHROME DW DRUM KIT

Journeyman drummer Brent Fitz used this DW drum kit extensively throughout 2014 and 2015 while performing with guitar legend Slash. In addition to his work with Slash, Brent has recorded and performed with Alice Cooper, Gene Simmons, Theory of a Deadman and a host of other luminaries.

SLY & THE FAMILY STONE JAPANESE STYLE JACKET

With iconic hits like "Dance to the Music", "Everyday People" and "Hot Fun in the Summertime", Sly & the Family Stone were among the most creative and influential acts to come out of the 1960s. This wildly talented group was also one of the first fully gender and racially integrated bands to hit the mainstream. Frontman Sly Stone wore this incredible jacket on stage in the '70s.

LES PAUL 2008 GIBSON LES PAUL STUDIO

This humble Les Paul Studio guitar belonged to Les Paul himself and was signed by many guitar icons including Slash, Billy Gibbons, Duane Eddy, The Ventures and many more.

MADONNA AMBERBURST PRS

This Paul Reed Smith guitar was used on stage throughout Madonna's 2001 'Drowned World' tour by guitarist Monte Pittman. Madonna originally met Monte when she took guitar lessons from him. She was so impressed with his skills, she hired him to be her musical director.

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
